The vast majority of the 279* fire stations are run by volunteer firefighters. When major fires occur, which are particularly common in the summer months, then they will welcome offers of water and sometimes other items.

Firefighters do not work 9am to 5 pm, and their hours can be very long often putting their lives in danger.

If you would like to donate any items to the voluntary fire service, then contact your local station, using the links below.

Please note that for obvious reasons they cannot provide a collection service, so donations need to be arranged either directly or indirectly.
