SAFETY ADVICES – COMMUN FAULTS :

- DOORS AND WINDOWS OPEN;
- ALARM NOT ACTIVATED;
- WALLS AND BARRIERS LOW;
- LIGHTING WEAK OR MISSING;
- DENSE VEGETATION AROUND THE HOUSE;
- BAD NEIGHBORHOOD;
- POOR SECURITY AWARENESS BY PERSONS;
- FACILITIES TO ACCESS TO HOUSING KEYS;
- DISCLOSURE OF THE CODE “SAFEKEY”;

- PROCEDURES TO ADOPT WHEN SOMEONE IS A VICTIM OF CRIME (Burglary)

REMEMBER (before):

- Register your goods in advance (photographically) with the registration No. and special features (ex. gold);
- Try to identify security weaknesses in your home or your Villas;

DURING / SHORTLY AFTER:

- Communicate immediately with the local police, or use the emergency number (112);
- If there is contact with the robbers, be cooperative. Stay calm and memorize as much signs and information;
- Look after your safety, even if that means you have to leave for a safe place;
- Avoid touching the objects (goods, doors, windows, other);

- PROCEDURES TO ADOPT WHEN SOMEONE IS A VICTIM OF CRIME (Burglary)

- Do not allow employees, neighbors or friends move around inside the housing until the arrival of the police;
- In case of forensics police act in daylight (sometimes its better to collect evidence), perform your tasks and routines in a compartment that the robbers did not use;
- Try to identify if there was any security breach and correct it when possible;

IMPORTANT:

- Most of the crimes of burglary are investigated immediately (Public Crime). If this is not the case, you may have to go to the police station to formalize the complaint;
- There is no cost involved in making a report but there is a charge for obtaining an insurance form;
- Sometimes it is necessary to go to the police station to perform other steps (statement or submit documentation - bring the NUIPC);
- Any request for information about the state of investigation should be directed to the public prosecutor - Leader of the investigation.

- WHAT PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANIES CAN DO TO HELP THEIR CLIENTS HAVE A SAFE HOLIDAY
 - Place emergency contacts numbers in a place where it is easily seen;
 - Draw up a list of top tips to keep the villa safe and secure when going out;
 - Encourage owners to fit safes in villas;
 - Keep a key register that contains a record of the issue and return of villa keys;
 - Help visitors, giving them safe advice - always in a positive way.

THE IMPORTANCE OF INTELLIGENCE:

- **Criminal Intelligence** falls within the scope of activity reported to the criminal investigation
- **Police Information** - are all those intended to contribute to the tasks legally assigned to a police services, whether strategic or operational level
 - Sharing all relevant information with your neighbors and local police, will help to:
 - Identify suspects;
 - Identify “Modus Operandi”
 - Prevent crimes
