

## Functions of the GNR – Criminal Investigation



- Coordinate the operation of the activities of the Guard in the area of criminal investigation, the operational aspects, criminology and criminal intelligence analysis;
- Develop, disseminate and ensure compliance with technical standards within the criminal activity;
- Technically support the units, proposing and disseminating instructions, in particular for the most serious crimes, complexity or territorial dispersion warranting the concentrated research management;
- Ensure the operation of an operating unit of research and collection of criminal information, centralizing the main means and special features research, evidence collection and technological support to investigations;
- Perform criminology skills and ensure support to the units in the technical and scientific police activities and the use of centralized means;
- To process criminal information in coordination with the management of information and ensure the dissemination of news and information;
- Follow the evolution of crime and the emergence of new tactics and techniques applicable to criminal investigation;
- Ensure, within their competence, coordination with other agencies, particularly in scientific police;
- Ensure the functioning of the trading activities in support units;
- Ensure the development of other tasks which, within their competence, are superiorly committed.
- Pursue other duties as assigned by law.
