

	<h1>Rules for Beaches</h1> <p>Bathing season: Started June 6</p>
General Beach rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Physical distance of 1.5 meters between each user, (who are not in the same group) - Distance of 3 meters between beach umbrellas/parasols - Sports activities with 2 or more people are forbidden (except for nautical activities, surf classes and similar sports) -
Awnings, thatched umbrellas and huts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - As a rule, each person or group can only rent this equipment in the morning (until 13h30) or in the afternoon (from 14h00) - Distance of 3 meters between awnings and parasols - Distance of 1.5 meters between the limits of tents - Max limit of 5 people per awning, parasol, tent - Possible exceptional extension of concession area
State of occupancy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - State of occupation announced through the signposting similar to traffic light signs: Green: low occupation (1/3) Yellow: high occupation (2/3) Red: full occupation (3/3) - Information updated in real time, namely in the app “InfoPraia” and the Portuguese Environment Agency APA’s website (www.apambiente.pt) - Parking is prohibited outside of the car parks and parking areas licensed for this purpose
Circulation rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One-way circulation direction with a physical distance of 1.5 meters - Circulation corridors, parallel and perpendicular to the coastline, may be defined
Bars, restaurants and outdoor terraces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Regular hygiene of spaces (minimum: 4 daily cleanings) - Maximum capacity limits, according to the terms applicable to restaurants and general sanitary rules - Possible reorganisation of outdoor terraces to ensure a safe distance
Mobile sales	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mandatory use of mask and visor by the seller in contact with users/customers - The circulation of street vendors should be done with physical distance and preferably through circulation corridors
Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Forbidden the use of pedal boats, slides or indoor showers is prohibited - Outdoor showers, sun loungers, mattresses or beach ashtrays should be sanitized daily or whenever a change of user occurs
General obligations for users	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Avoid access to areas with high or full occupation - Mandatory use of hand sanitiser upon arrival at the beach and regularly thereafter - Ensure physical safety distance when using the beach and bathing
