



- Unless needed, leave valuable items in your home or hotel safe.
- In beach car parks, do not park in a place which may obstruct others.
- No not leave valuable items in your car.
- ♣ Take care that you are not observed placing items in the boot of your car beware of distraction crime.
- ♣ Make sure you lock your car and leave no items on display. If alone, find a beach space in view of others.
