



## **Recommendation of the Public Security Police**

## If you own a firearm ... these are the 10 safety rules for firing and weapon handling

Just purchased a hunting weapon or for self-defence, do you know how it handles? Do you know how the security mechanism works?

- 1. Always treat firearms as if they were loaded;
- 2. Never point a gun, unless you intend to fire it;
- 3. Never ask whether or not the weapons are loaded. Check yourself and take appropriate precautions;
- 4. Always make sure the barrel is properly cleaned of oil or any possible obstructions;
- 5. Always avoid "playing" with guns or dry shooting, unless it is in an appropriate location for this purpose.
- 6. Always make sure of the target before pulling the trigger;
- 7. Never shoot at hard or flat surfaces. Avoid this anyway as it may result in ricochets;
- 8. Always store weapons and ammunition separately, if possible under lock and key and out of reach of children;
- 9. Always avoid drinking alcohol before or during a session when carrying, shooting or activity hunting;
- 10. Remember, weapons in themselves are not dangerous. It all depends on who and how uses them. Always bear in mind "the weapons, rarely give an opportunity to commit a second mistake"
